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Sentimental—is that the soul feeling inside of me?

What is that sentimental feeling, but the memory of souls interacting. A man remembering his Norwegian grandmother, told me recently that as a boy growing up, he helped her by doing yard chores for her. She would stand nearby directing him as he trimmed trees and bushes; planted and tended her garden. Now, years later and long after she's been gone he said, "If I knew then that those were going to be the best years of my life I would have paid more attention."

The memory of the soul's interactions are the most cherished of memories, that is why we revert to being our soul when we are around a baby. I do not mean baby talk; I mean our hearts open up and we become softer and gentler. That is the soul—your soul interacting with the soul of the baby. Those are the memories of childhood that we remember by feeling them—it is when we feel the same comfort and love and joy that souls bring to each other's hearts that we remember what it was like to be the soul. We remember the feeling of being with the souls of people.

I was fortunate to have soul people in my life. My father was one. He was a constant reminder of who I was—I was the soul. I knew it every time I looked into his face and into his eyes. I could feel his love—without words. I could see his soul in his eyes. Souls talk without words with their eyes. My heart and my soul were touched by his smile. And that is all we, as the soul, need to do to fill the hearts and touch the souls of every person we meet: every child and every adult. That is the way we awaken the souls within the people we have around us—be the soul and let people feel the presence of your soul.

If young people grow up and become ego-bound the quickest way to bring them back to experiencing their souls is when they have a baby. Babies remind us of the soul we are within.

Of course for many parents the ego has over-booked the activities of the day making it very hard for the soul to live and to work. The child learns about survival in the presence of ego-bound parents. Soon the ego-personality: anger takes the place of the soul's unhappy crying for food, for comfort, for safety, for thirst, for love. The ego is born only after the soul learns that it may starve or suffer if its needs and wants are not met.

The soul has wants and needs. The soul is meant to live your life. When the ego takes over living the life, the soul's needs and wants are not met. People who have lived most of their lives as egos have trouble deciding what they really want to do or have or be. Why?

1. Because the soul inside is so immature, it is a baby who has not been allowed to talk or express its needs or wants.
2. The ego has dragged the soul around, dragging it into its life of lies, lies and more lies. The ego is a liar, the soul tells the truth.
3. The life that the ego has been living is not the life the soul has chosen.

Here in this first reference #55 Eckhart Tolle and I differ. The soul has valid needs and if they are not met, the soul has fear; which leads to developing an ego-personality.

Eckhart Tolle is mistaking the needs of the soul for the synthetic needs of the ego. Each ego need is just to feed the ego-personality. The ego is created by the fact that the needs and wants of the soul are not met.

In this example #55 he is saying *that an ego wants something....(and) play(s) (a) role*

You see the ego is a role, it does not play a role. The soul is unique and spontaneous and there are no two alike: the soul does not play a role unless it takes on an ego.
