Why can't you be the soul and still have an ego?

- The ego is a liar in everything it does and says. Look at the list.
- The soul tells the truth in everything it does and says.
- You cannot lie and tell the truth at the same time

Unraveling Your Past to Get Into the Present lists the ego-personalities on a few pages—five to be exact. The rest of the book is how to develop your soul-personality—264 pages to give you an idea. There are books to follow this one as soon as there are people who want them.

My father, Albin Emile Havig, told me when he dropped me at my dorm in my first year of college,

"Fools learn from experience; wise men from observation."

I was a fool right away. Seventeen years old, freedom for the first time: experience was my teacher.

By the end of the second year I got a grip on myself: observation seemed like a better teacher.

So, just like you cannot be the soul and have an ego, you cannot be a fool and be a wise man at the same time.

A man told me recently that he was disappointed in his life. Oh, I said look at all the children you raised. "Yes," he said, "but look at what your father did for you."

"What do you mean?" I asked him.

“He taught you to love God.” he replied.
“Yes, he did.” I said. “I do love God.”

I knew that I learned to love people’s souls from my father. Loving God was easy. My father loved Him and so do I. *Thank you Daddy.*

It is easy to see the soul when you compare them to people with ego-personalities.

- The ego-personalities are cold; the soul is warm.
 - The ego-personalities are distant; the soul is right there with you—in the moment.
 - The ego-personalities are glassy eyed; the soul’s eyes are bright and responsive to every word and deed.
1. Become aware of when you are an ego-personality, that is the first step.
 2. Become aware of when someone else is an ego-personality, that is another step.
