Opinions mean nothing unless the facts are there to support them. Before the Iraqi Freedom War, loud voices sounded out against the Iraqi people and against President George W. Bush. You see, the Iraqi people were on the same side as President Bush! It seems now that the loud voices were without facts but that their prayers were answered along with the prayers of the proponents of war, the soldiers and their families.

- The human chains failed to ask the Iraqi people what they wanted. They found out by watching the joy of the people in Iraq as they were finally liberated.
- The loud voices predicted millions of refugees. People went into Iraq during the month long war but few left. People stayed knowing they were to be liberated.
- President Bush's name was loudly spoken in the same sentence with Hitler. April 9th showed the world who President Bush really is. An Iraqi carried a picture of President Bush with "President Bush Peacemaker" written above it. People kissed pictures of President Bush and the soldiers cheeks as well.

The ego is not informed, takes no time to learn the truth and will not admit its mistakes. The ego is an actress or an actor playing you, the soul. The ego is a liar and a fabricator. Is that how you want to live your life? Being uninformed about what is really the truth?

- Parents of abused children keep quiet about the abuse as did the Peace Movement. Why? Both are making choices from the ego. The ego wants something: money (social programs), sex (abortions), to be taken care of (which is what the socialists and communists in the Peace movement wanted) but who will take
